

Cookie Policy

1. General information

This Cookie Policy describes the different types of cookies and other technologies that may be used in connection with the website owned or controlled by JustMarkets “JustMarkets”, "we," or "us").

This Cookie Policy describes how the Company will use cookies to distinguish you from other users of the Website. The Company uses cookies to provide effective work on the site and to create statistical reports. This helps us to provide you with a more relevant and effective experience when you browse our Website, including presenting websites according to your needs or preferences and it allows us to improve the site generally.

This Cookie Policy provides you with comprehensive information about the cookies we use and the way in which we use them. You should also read our Privacy Policy in conjunction with this Policy.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that contain data on Client activity on the Company's website. They are installed on the Client's computer when the Client visits the Company's website and when the Client visits it for the next time, they extract this information.

Cookies contain a string of characters and it is the identifier of the Client's browser. These files are used for tracking visitors to the website and providing faster and more convenient access. This information does not identify Clients, it just lets the Company estimate the Client's interest in the services of the Company and activity on the site. All the information is anonymous.

Some of our business partners (i.e. advertisers) use cookies on our Website. We have no access to, or control over, these cookies.

3. How to manage Cookies?

Cookies are frequently used on many websites on the internet and you can choose if and how a cookie will be accepted by changing your preferences and options in your browser.

You can stop receiving cookies by choosing the appropriate command in the menu of the browser.

Alternatively, you could visit www.aboutcookies.org, which contains comprehensive information on cookies on a wide variety of browsers. You'll also find details on how to delete cookies from your computer.

If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of the website of the Company may become inaccessible or not function properly.

4. Your consent

By continuing to use our Website, you are agreeing to our placing cookies on your computer in order to analyze the way you use our Website. Please be aware that if you choose not to accept cookies, you may not be able to take full advantage of this website

5. The way in which we use cookies

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- To allow you to carry information across pages of our site and avoid having to re-enter information.
- Within registration allows you to access stored information.
- Non-personal data for tagging purposes only.
- To help us recognise you as a unique visitor (a number) when you return to our website and to allow us to tailor content or advertisements to match your preferred interests or to avoid showing you the same adverts repeatedly.
- To compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how users use our site and to help us improve the structure of our website.
- To internally identify you by account name, name, email address, customer ID, currency and location (geographic and computer ID/IP address).
- To differentiate users who are on the same network to enable us to correctly allocate transactions to the appropriate account.
- Within research surveys to ensure you are not invited to complete a questionnaire too often or after you have already done so.
- To serve advertisements on our Site and track whether these advertisements are clicked on by users.
- To control how often you are shown a particular advertisement.
- To tailor content to your preferences.
- To count the number of anonymous users of our site.
- For website usage analysis.

6. You can be sure that the cookies used by our website(s):

- Do not store any personally identifiable information such as passwords;
- Do not access any other information stored on your computer;
- Do not compromise the security of your device(s);
- Do not transfer viruses or malware to your computer.

7. Third-Party cookies

We may also use Third party software to track and analyze usage and volume statistical information including page requests, form requests and click paths. The Third party may use cookies to track behaviour and may set cookies on behalf of the Company.

The company's website may contain links to third-party websites. If you visit these websites, the Company's cookie policy no longer applies. We recommend that you visit these websites and read their policies before you use these websites.
